

Aubergine Parmigiana Lasagne

Ingredients

3 large aubergines trimmed and thinly sliced lengthways

4 tbsp olive oil

250g vegetarian mozzarella, drained and grated 50g vegetarian Italian-style hard cheese grated 1 bunch of basil leaves roughly chopped, leaving some for garnish

8 dried lasagne sheets (egg lasagne sheets work best)

For The Tomato Sauce:

2 tbsp olive oil

6 garlic cloves finely sliced chopped ¼ tsp golden caster sugar

1 tbsp red wine vinegar 3 x 400g cans chopped tomatoes

Preparation time: 5 minutes

Cooking Time: 20 minutes

Servings: 2

Method

The sauce: Heat the oil in a large pan over a medium heat and fry the garlic for 1 min until golden. Add the sugar and vinegar, simmer for 30 seconds, then add the tomatoes. Season with salt and return to a simmer for 10 mins. Remove from the heat and set aside. This can be prepared up to two days ahead and chilled until required.

Heat a griddle or large frying pan over a mediumhigh heat. Brush the aubergine slices on both sides with the olive oil and season with a little salt. Gridle the slices in batches until softened and slightly charred (ensure the heat isn't too high or the aubergine will char before it softens). Transfer the cooked slices to a plate as you go.

To assemble: Place a third of the aubergine slices in a layer over the base of a rectangular or square oven-proof dish, then pour over a third of the sauce. Scatter with a small handful of both cheeses and half the basil. Keep most of the cheese for the top. Cover the aubergine layer with half the lasagne sheets. Repeat once more, then finish with a final layer of aubergines topped with the rest of the sauce. Scatter the remaining cheese over the top. After leaving to cool completely this can be frozen so it's a great dish to prepare ahead for busy families. Defrost fully before cooking.

Heat the oven to 200C/180C fan/gas 6. Place the dish on a baking tray and bake for 30 mins until the cheese is golden and the sauce is bubbling at the edges. Leave to cool for at least 10 mins, then scatter with the reserved basil and serve with a green salad.

How to choose the perfect vet for your beloved pet.

Finding the right veterinarian is one of the most important decisions a pet owner can make. A good vet is not only a skilled medical professional but also a partner in your pet's overall wellbeing. If possible, visit the surgery to check it is clean, organised and has high standards. A veterinarian should be approachable and willing to explain medical terms and procedures in a way you can understand, because your pet's health depends on clear communication.

Also, remember that emergencies can happen at any time. Check whether the clinic offers emergency services or has a partnership with a nearby animal hospital.

Petcare can be costly, so it's wise to compare pricing among different clinics. Ensure that the vet provides transparent billing and discusses costs upfront for treatments. Many clinics offer payment plans or pet insurance options to ease the financial burden, but if you are really in a tight spot money-wise, look into charity-run hospital who can offer reduced rates for those on low incomes. Never ever let your financial problems stop you from seeking help for your pet, as there will always be someone willing to help an animal in need.

Just like a decent doctor, a good vet should demonstrate genuine care and compassion for animals. Observe how they interact with your pet during your first visit. Do they handle your pet gently and with patience? Small gestures of kindness can reveal a lot about their attitude. After all, the best medicine in the world, is love.

September Gardening

September is a busy month in the garden as you harvest crops, prune and divide, and prepare for autumn and beyond.

Harvest Time

Because the month of September is a transitional month for the weather and the seasons, it is a busy month for gardeners, especially as they harvest the fruits of their labours.

Summer fruits and vegetables such as tomatoes, courgettes, and runner beans are still going strong this month gracing our tables and making us think of different ways of preserving our bounty. Whilst beans do freeze well, tomatoes do not unless you make sauces so consider more traditional methods of preserving such as picking or bottling.

Blackberries and plums should still be cropping whilst autumn fruiting raspberries are coming into their own. Squashes are just starting to crop, but until they are picked ensure larger fruits are kept well clear of the ground with straw.

Looking Forward

Take cuttings - September is the perfect month to take cuttings from plants such as fuchsias and hebe because hormone levels are high and this will encourage them to take. **Divide Plants** - herbaceous perennials such as geums divide easily. Geums come in a huge variety of colours and are a really great value plant as you can divide them and get more and more. Simply lift the plant out of the ground and it should divide up quite readily. You could easily get six smaller plants from one large one. Geums grow tall so add a brilliant extra dimension to the border.

Gather Seeds - harvesting the seeds from flowering plants can save you money and is hugely satisfying. Sunflowers are perhaps one of the easiest flowers to gather seeds from as the seeds and heads are so big. Simply wait until the head dries and then cut it off, hang it upside down and shake, or rub the head until the seeds come out.

Lay a New Lawn

September is a good month to lay a new lawn because the soil is still warm and there is usually enough rain to allow it to grow. You can create a new lawn by either using seed or buying turf. Using seed is the cheaper option but you will need patience, and it is best to start early in the month unless the weather is very hot and dry. Turf offers a quicker result, but it can be hard physical work and possibly the job for a professional. Both seed and turf come in numerous choices that include popular wildflower lawns.

Other September Jobs

Weeds are still growing vigorously in gardens so tackle them regularly. Depending on the weather slugs and snails could still be abundant too so be watchful. To make sure your beautiful pots and hanging baskets continue flowering until the first frosts dead head them and water regularly. Ponds need to be netted to stop leaves falling in and clean and tidy greenhouses and cold frames in readiness for autumn use.

Five BIG HOLIDAY mistakes to avoid.

Holidays are a chance to relax, unwind and transport yourself to a different place, mentally and physically.

That's why when things go wrong during this special time of the year, it can be disheartening.

However, you can steer away from stress by circumnavigating these common holiday horrors.

Travel restrictions

You may have a place in mind, but long before concerning yourself over passport, travel insurance and vaccinations, give a final check that your destination is somewhere safe.

Natural disasters, political conflicts and social unrest are just a few of the reasons a place may find itself on the no-go list. Some of these elements may change frequently given we are in fast-moving times.

You can find guidance on the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office (FCDO) website and it's worth checking this information often in the weeks leading up to your holiday. In the past the FCDO has issued various travel warnings, including advice against 'all travel' and 'all but essential travel' to entire countries or parts of countries, so don't get caught out.

Scams

Scam websites on the internet are nothing new, and there is nothing more devastating than paying out for a dream trip only to realise you can't even make it through Passport Control.

To check if a holiday company is legitimate, look for suspicious language, typos, ensure there is clear contact information, website reviews, and membership in reputable trade bodies like ABTA or IATA. Verify the company's ATOL (Air Travel Organisers' Licence) if it offers flights, and avoid companies that request payment outside of secure systems.

Delays

Some delays are inevitable, but there are steps you can take to make it less likely. For example, if you're taking a short haul flight on a budget airline, it's best to get the first flight as planes will likely be going to and from mainland Europe several times in one day, so delays can accumulate. Also, download the app of the airline you're travelling with for regular updates.

Overpaying

Even if the website hollars 'hotel in demand... one room left!!' do not book anything on a whim. Companies often use this as a tactic to pressure customers into booking, but it is always worth checking your options.

Visit price comparison websites, read reviews of hotels so you can be sure it offers the standards promised and, if in doubt, book via a travel agent who will source the best deal.

Culture clashes

Some countries have different cultures to the UK. In France for example, this often means ladies will sunbathe topless on the beach, however if you try that in some Middle Eastern countries you are likely to get arrested.

Ultimately, it comes down to respect for a location and its people, so take time to ensure a destination matches with your own values, persona and identity.
